One (1) Bulk Clean-up In 2021

Cleanup week May 10 to May 14, 2021, Containerized Sanitation will be picking up the garbage for spring cleanup, they will be following the same route as the regular garbage pickup.

Spring Clean-Up is the special collection of general household items that are too bulky for normal collection. During this period, residents are requested to make a special effort to clean up their properties.

Residents are asked to have all items out to the curb by Monday, May 10, 2021 8:00am. Once an area has been completed, it will **not be** visited again.

All items must be placed near the curbside/roadside.

Metal items must be separated from all other items.

All items must be separated into the three approved piles Metal – Bulk or Household.

Items for pickup **must** be bagged, boxed or bound (**no more than 40lbs**) as large piles of small debris will not be collected unless it is contained. **Maximum length for any item is 4 feet (48 inches)**. Items must still follow Sort It Western Guidelines using blue or clear bags.
